Bragg Creek Days Fun Run

Calling all runners! Come join us for our annual **Bragg Creek Days Fun Run** on **Sunday July 18th** (see attached entry forms for details). Funds raised from the Fun Run will be donated to the Greater Bragg Creek Trails Association (GBCTA) for future trail building projects.

The Greater Bragg Creek Trails Association has two primary functions which include building pathways that connect the community within the Bragg Creek area and volunteer ski trail grooming, maintenance and trail development on the trails within West Bragg Kananaskis Country.

Since its creation in 2005, the association has completed: The Centennial Trail (Bragg Creek Provincial Park to the Hamlet), The Banded Peak Trail (Banded Peak School to the Community Centre) and a planning document for the West Bragg Creek Trail (Hamlet to the West Bragg Creek Trail system in K-Country). Currently the Association is working on an All-Seasons Trail Plan for West Bragg Kananaskis Country that would add 40 km of new summer trails and additional winter ski trails. The Association is also planning a new community trail which would make a circular loop that includes the Banded Peak Trail, the Provincial Park Trails and the Centennial Trail.

If you are unable to run, please consider volunteering or making a donation. As we are a charitable organization, we will issue tax receipts for all cash and gift in kind donations.
